Scholarship

Eligibility Requirement & Details

To be eligible for this \$1,000 scholarship, the applicant must be a student entering their second, third, or fourth year of a four-year institution of higher learning, or the second year of a two-year institution of higher learning with a major involving crop production.

Students must submit the requirements as listed here and have the package
postmarked by November 1, 2025:

- A completed copy of the application form.
- The applicant must have a declared major in an agricultural related field of study.
Preference given to applicants that have declared a major focusing on crop production.
- The applicant must be a Minnesota resident.
- The applicant must complete and include two essays as follows:
 1. Explain in 500 words or less why you decided to major in agriculture and your post-graduation plans.
 2. Describe in 500 words or less any ag-related or leadership programs or projects you have been involved with in high school, college or elsewhere.
- One letter of recommendation.
- Most recent official student transcript from the applicant's school.

December 2-4, 2025 at the Minneapolis Hilton Hotel.

The MCPR Executive Committee reserves the right to not award the scholarship based on the lack of qualified candidates.
