UMN-AFREC Communications Update

Here is a recap of UMN-AFREC communications work in April, May and June 2024, and a look at what is happening in the months ahead

QUICK NOTES

 In May, the Minnesota Legislature extended the AFREC program through 2030, with some changes. Contact AFREC Research Coordinator Bruce Montgomery (<u>afrecmonty@comcast.net</u>) with any questions.

APRIL

- Fabian Fernandez presented to the Subcommittee on Minnesota Water Policy about <u>AFREC's role in protecting</u> <u>water quality</u>. Two print handouts on this topic were also made and distributed to legislators.
- In our April podcast episode, Dan Kaiser, Jeff Vetsch, and Seth Naeve discussed <u>soybean fertility</u>, garnering over 1,000 clicks.
- Dan Kaiser wrote about nutrient management issues to watch out for in fields with <u>unharvested sugarbeets</u>. He also discussed sugarbeet nutrient management on NDSU's <u>Sugarbeet</u> <u>Report podcast</u>.
- Dan Kaiser promoted <u>FRST (the</u> <u>Fertilizer Recommendation Support</u> <u>Tool)</u> on the blog. Dan was interviewed about the tool for articles in <u>AgWeek</u> and <u>DTN/Progressive Farmer</u>.
- Brad Carlson's blog post on <u>fertilizer</u> <u>costs</u>, <u>profitability</u>, <u>and overapplication</u> tallied 1,800 views. It led to a <u>Linder</u> <u>Farm Network video</u> with Brad.
- Dan Kaiser's post about <u>sulfur for</u> <u>soybean</u> earned over 1,300 views.



U of *M* researchers and educators have been actively responding to the latest conditions as farmers and advisors seek to make informed supplemental nitrogen decisions.

- Anna Cates and colleagues summarized their research on <u>field workability and</u> <u>soil health</u> in a blog post.
- In AgWeek, AFREC Ex Officio member Jeff Kosek sounded the alarm about what losing AFREC would mean for Minnesota, Dan Kaiser discussed nitrogen requirements for dry edible beans, and Jeff Strock and Lindsay Pease addressed <u>drain tile and disease</u> reduction research in dry edible beans.

MAY

- Dan Glessing, president of the Minnesota Farm Bureau Federation, talked about AFREC in the Minnesota Legislature on the <u>Linder Farm Network</u>.
- Warren Formo recapped the 2024 AFREC-funded nutrient management conferences for <u>The Farmer Magazine</u>.
- Dan Kaiser, Jeff Coulter, Yuxin Miao, and Fabian Fernandez examined <u>current</u> <u>research on nitrogen and sulfur</u> for the May podcast episode.

- Brad Carlson and Dan Kaiser debuted the Advancing Nitrogen Smart series of podcasts and videos with an <u>introductory post</u>. The first two podcast episodes were on <u>nitrogen placement</u> and <u>statewide nitrogen BMPs</u>.
- Lindsay Pease did three AFRECsponsored Soil Fertility Minute radio spots on the Red River Farm Network this quarter, including one on her <u>AFREC drainage research project</u>.


JUNE

- Brad Carlson's blog post on <u>supplemental nitrogen</u> received over 2,200 clicks and was highlighted in <u>DTN/Progressive Farmer</u>.
- Our June podcast episode on <u>nitrogenfixing biological products</u> featured Dan Kaiser, Carl Rosen, and two out-of-state guests: Emerson Nafziger from the University of Illinois and Dave Franzen from North Dakota State University. The post garnered over 2,000 clicks and was covered in a <u>DTN/Progressive Farmer</u> <u>feature article</u>.
- In the middle of June, we put out an emergency podcast on <u>supplemental</u> <u>nitrogen</u> with Dan Kaiser, Fabian Fernandez, Jeff Vetsch, and Brad Carlson. The episode received over 1,700 clicks.
- Advancing Nitrogen Smart continued with podcast episodes on <u>nitrogen</u> <u>carryover</u> and <u>sidedressing</u>, as well as several timely <u>short videos</u>.
- Vasu Sharma blogged about <u>irrigation</u> <u>timing after a rainy start</u>.

- There were three AFREC Spotlight radio segments on the Linder Farm Network this quarter: Fabian Fernandez on <u>sidedressing nitrogen</u>, Vasu Sharma on her <u>AFREC nitrogen and irrigation</u> <u>study</u>, and Dan Kaiser on <u>sulfur</u> <u>availability</u>.
- For media appearances, Melissa Wilson was interviewed for an article in the print edition of <u>Manure Manager</u> on her ManureDB project and Brad Carlson was interviewed by <u>Brownfield Ag News</u> about nitrogen loss.

- George Rehm will be posthumously awarded the Agricultural Communicators Network's <u>2024</u> <u>Distinguished Service Award</u> in August. Members of George's family will accept the award at ACN's conference.
